




IMPORTANT TRENDS AND HIGHLIGHTS

- The U.S. is the 4th study abroad destination for Austrian students, following Germany, the United Kingdom, and Switzerland. (Source: UNESCO 2013)
- The number of Austrians studying in the U.S. increased by 4.9% between 2013/14 and 2014/15.
- In the past 5 years, the number of Austrian degree-seeking students, both undergraduate and graduate, going to the United States has remained stable. There has been growing interest in non-degree program, with a 13.9% increase over 5 years.
- The top host institutions are the University of Illinois - Urbana-Champaign, Columbia University, Harvard University, New York University, and the University of New Orleans.
