

MEDIA INTERN

Fulbright Austria is seeking a media intern to work directly with their social media coordinator. This is an exciting opportunity to build your resume for a semester working with a dynamic small team in an international organization. Fulbright Austria creates opportunities for US citizens to research, teach and study in Austria and for Austrians to do the same in the US.

The media intern's primary responsibility will be to take and edit photos and videos of Fulbright events and of grantees at various locations in Vienna. Your own creative ideas are most welcome.

Prospective interns should have experience in photography and video editing. An interest in storytelling and creating interesting and dynamic images is a must. A fixed mirror camera with video capability and an iMac with iMovie are available for the intern's use, but candidates can also use their own equipment.

Position averages out to approximately 10 hours per week over the course of the semester, with flexible hours (you will shoot events and have assignments with deadlines, but will sometimes be able to arrange to shoot grantees at mutually agreeable times and edit shots and video on your own time.) You will need to be present for occasional Fulbright events.

We depend on your creative input and are excited to integrate your suggestions and creations into our overall media strategy!

Upon satisfactory completion of your one-to-two-semester-long internship, you will receive a small honorar and are free to use the materials created as part of your portfolio.
